

- Considerations for system and organisation controls (SOC) engagements

Duration of the exam: 4 hours

Exam pattern:

- 82 multiple choice questions (50% weightage)
- 6 short task-based simulations (50% weightage)

*Candidates must pass all four parts within 18 months of passing the first examination with a minimum score of 75 out of 100 in each part.



Way to becoming a CPA

Eligibility checks and evaluation

- Determining the eligibility for writing the exam with one of the 55 jurisdictions (state boards)
- Evaluating educational credentials by the National Association of State Boards of Accountancy's (NASBA) International Evaluation Services (IES)

Chart your path to clear the CPA exam and earn the CPA license

Step 1: Clear the AICPA's CPA examination {from any of the eligible 55 State Boards of Accountancy [SBA]}

Minimum education requirements for US CPA exam: 120 credits

As a general rule, each university year in India gives 30 credits to the students.

So, a three-year graduation degree from any of the Indian universities gives 90 credits.

As an exception, a B.Com Honours from an NAAC A, A+ accredited university with a first division is considered to be 120 credits equating to a bachelor's degree from the US.

In a snapshot, the following thumb rules can be followed:

Using 1 year = 30 credits

- B.Com = 3 years x 30 credits = 90 credits
- B.Com + M.Com/MBA = 90 credits + 60 credits = 150 credits
- B.Com + CA/CS/CWA = 90 credits + 60 credits = 150 credits
- CA/CS/CWA is recognised by a few states as 2-3 years of US education


Step 2: Get the CPA license {by any of the eligible 55 State Board of Accountancy [SBA]}

Minimum education requirements for US CPA license:150 credits

Grant Thornton Bharat will guide you end-to-end for the process of completing your journey from clearing the examination to getting your CPA license.

The extra 30 credits can be earned by pursuing any one-year diploma courses in the fields of accounting and finance.

In addition to the education criteria, you also need to clear the Ethics exam and get your experience verified from a licensed CPA.
